The Wareham Gatemen Organization is looking for a Videographer to serve as the official team videographer in 2020. This intern will be focused on taking photos for the Gatemen website and area news publications. This internship is a unique opportunity to cover a baseball team with absolute access to the team, coaching staff and game action. You do not need to be an expert, but rather have a thirst for learning and growing as a videographer. Intern must provide own equipment. Internship runs from June 1, 2020 through end of season, including playoffs. A small stipend will be provided. Housing is not provided. Great opportunity for a local college student to gain valuable experience in video productions and videography. **Reports to:** Tom Gay, Gatemen President

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Must attend all Gatemen games including any pre and post season games.
- Work with broadcast team on preproduction of games and studio content.
- Video live game action, behind the scenes and community relations events.
- Create file of all material collected during season on drive provided by Gatemen.
- Work with Broadcast team on all content produced.
- Facets of the program include, this is not an exhaustive list:
 - Setting up and working video shoots
 - Video graphic design
 - Editing vignettes
- Post stories on Gatemen social media.
- Working with Broadcast team on marketing scripts, scripts for game coverage, show ideas, etc...
- Working with Broadcast team on in-game coverage, stories and interviews.
- Work with Broadcast team on pre and post-game show.
- Work with broadcast team on studio produced content and shows
- Work with Broadcast team on social media stories and posts.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- Knowledge of the game action of baseball and familiarity with MLB game productions
- Knowledge of YouTube Live Stream
- Experience with image / video editing software
- Capacity to handle a variety of projects in a changing environment
- Ability to learn very quickly
- Ability to pay close attention to detail
- Ability to work independently
- Must have a working knowledge of baseball

Work Environment and Schedule:

- Work is normally performed in a field environment and there may be exposure to adverse weather conditions.
- Flexibility in scheduling is required and will involve some evenings, weekends, and holidays.
- Must be able to work all Gatemen games.
- Must provide own travel to away games.
